4. The Bursary Committee of the B.C. Cattlemen's Association is empowered to:
 - (a) grant this bursary at its discretion;
 - (b) withhold this bursary in any year if there are no eligible applicants, or for any reason deemed good or advisable.
5. The Bursary will be payable on receipt by the Association of documentation confirming acceptance into the institution for post secondary education.
6. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
