The BCCA PDI will be accepting Request for Quotes for the upcoming Provincial Range/Fire Fencing Program, fencing near Cache Creek located in the Thompson Rivers Natural Resource District. All Qualified Fencing Contractor quoters are required to attend the viewing. Project works includes:

**BCCA PDI Project Number: R203 Scottie Creek (SC 8/15/21/26)**

**Project #1: SC 8 Removal**

- Fence Line Removal of approximately **80 meters** of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.

**Project #2: SC 15 Replacement**

- Fence Line Removal and Replacement of approximately **1,280 meters** of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.

**Project #3: SC 15 Removal**

- Fence Line Removal of approximately **550 meters** of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.

**Project #4: SC 15 Water Development**

- Fence Line Removal and Replacement of approximately **60 meters** of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.

**Project #5: SC 21 New Construction**

- Fence Line New Construction of approximately **105 meters** of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.

**Project #6: SC 26 Replacement**

- Fence Line Removal and Replacement of approximately **1,700 meters** of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.
- **Creek crossing window of work opportunity on Scottie Creek is from July 22 to October 31. Fence Construction must take place during this time.**

**Note there is extensive areas of minimal ground disturbance on the above projects. Restrictions will apply and specifics will be listed in the quote document.**

**Fence viewing is mandatory** and will be held on **Thursday September 17, 2020**. Meeting time will be **8:30AM** with a marshaling point at **the Husky in Cache Creek, BC**. If a representative will be viewing on your behalf, written notification must be sent to the office listed below, via fax or email prior to the viewing. Probationary contractors must attend the site visit in person, no alternate parties can represent the probationary contractors.

Completion date for the **BCCA PDI Project Number: R203 Scottie Creek (SC 8/15/21/26)** will be **December 31, 2020**.

**Please ensure you are aware of the Coronavirus Screening Process:**

**Each person attending work must be asked 5 questions:**

1. Are you currently experiencing any cold or flu-like symptoms?
2. Have you travelled to any countries outside Canada (including the United States) within the last 14 days?
3. Did you provide care or have close contact with a person with COVID-19 (probable or confirmed) while they were ill (cough, fever, sneezing, or sore throat) within the last 14 days?
4. Did you have close contact with a person who travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days who has become ill (cough, fever, sneezing, or sore throat)?
5. Have you or anybody in your home had contact with someone who is being tested for COVID-19 or who has been diagnosed with COVID-19.

**If the answer is YES to ANY of the above questions, please notify our office.**
