Project #1: Remove & Replace (Woods Lake Powerline)

- Fence Line Removal and Replacement of approximately 2,689 meters of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.

Project #2: Remove & Replace (Range Rd Drift)

- Fence Line Removal and Replacement of approximately 290 meters of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.

Fence viewing is mandatory and will be held on **May 13, 2026**. Meeting time will be **7:00 AM** with a marshaling point at Big Sky Station in Savona. Please notify the office if you or a representative for you will be attending prior to the viewing Probationary contractors must attend the site visit in person, no alternate parties can represent the probationary contractors.

Quad is required.
